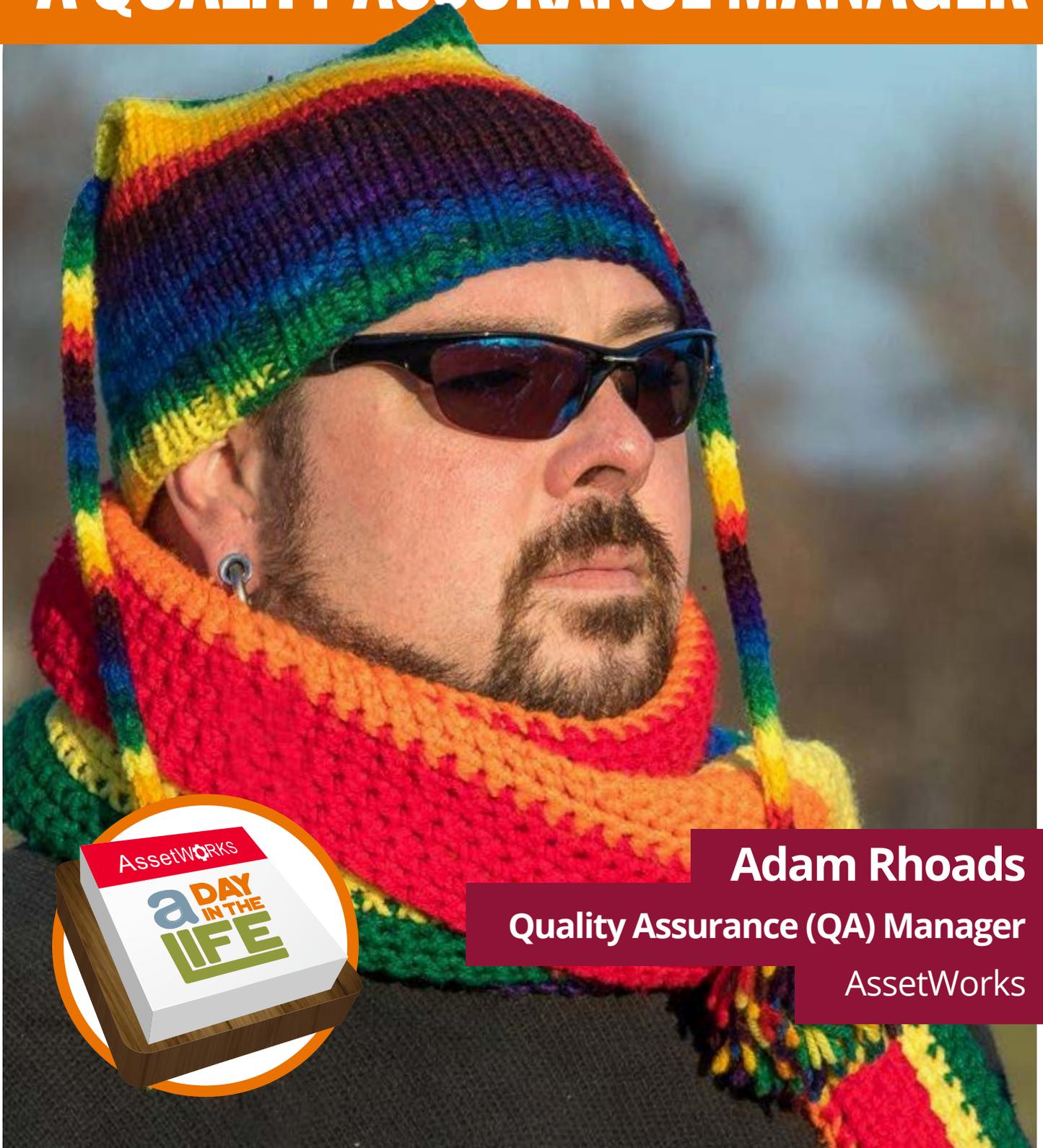


A DAY IN THE LIFE OF... A QUALITY ASSURANCE MANAGER

Welcome to a day in the life of a QA manager.

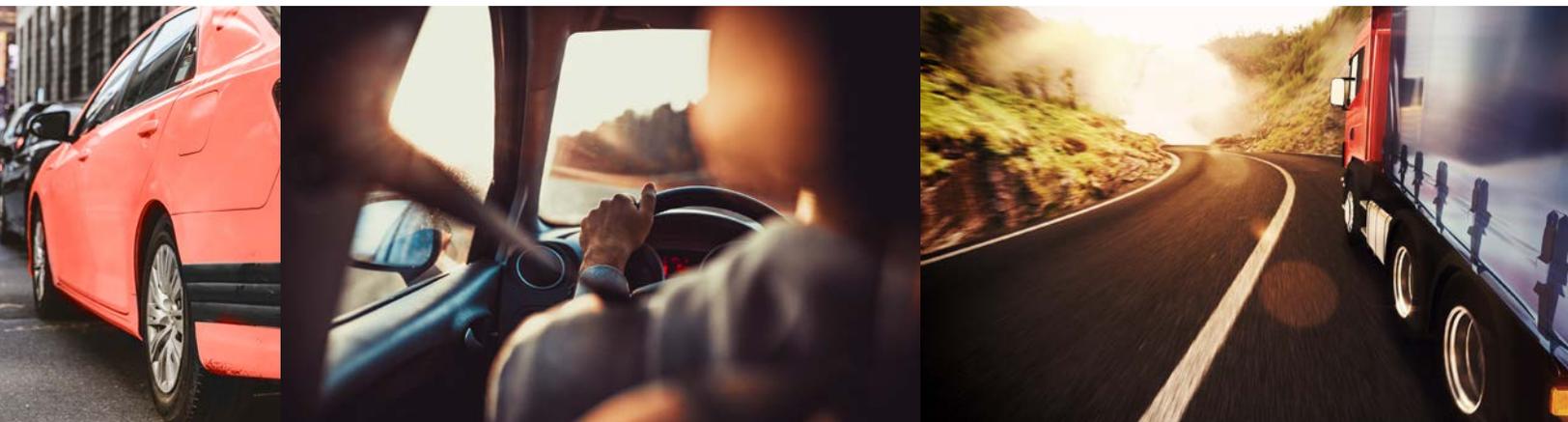
WHAT IS QA, ANYWAY?

- Reads through what items other QA resources have created

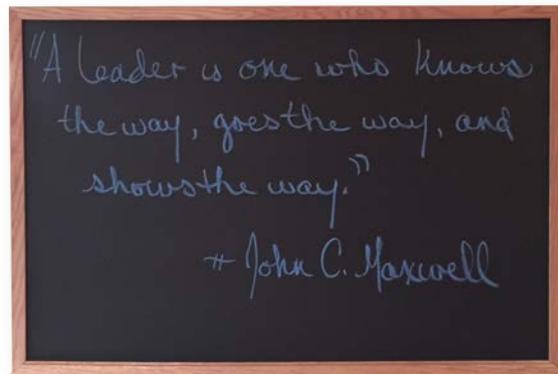
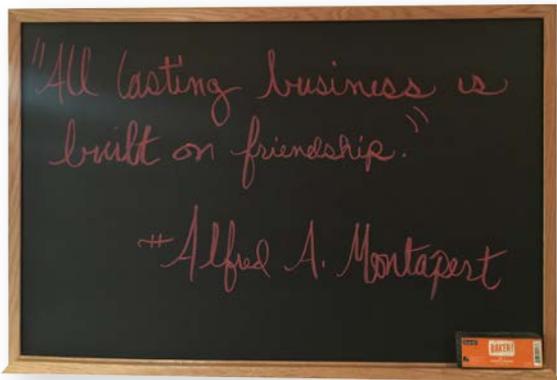


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#WAYNESPIRATIONS
